



Dear Parents, Pupils and Staff,

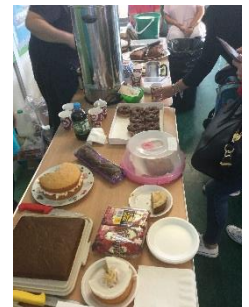
As another week flies by I find it hard to believe it is October next week!


