Years EYFS, 1, 2, 3, 4, & 5

Bottle green jumper or cardigan with school logo Grey trousers, or grey skirt or grey pinafore. White polo shirts (with school logo) Optional – bottle green fleece (for outside wear only)

Year 6 Only

To wear a tie, with a white shirt (not polo shirt) & v neck bottle green jumper or cardigan Optional – bottle green fleece (for outside wear only)

Summer term - All years

Green check summer dresses & grey school wear shorts (not sports shorts)

All children to wear Black school shoes (no trainers)

Jewellery

Due to Health and Safety reasons children can only wear simple watches to school, children should not wear any other items of jewellery. If worn, studs must be removed or taped over for all P.E. lessons.

Make-up

Children are not permitted to wear any make-up including nail varnish.


Silver Headteacher Award

MEDICATION


