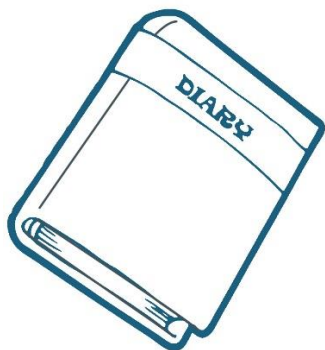
Cricket Update
