Where our pupils travel from

Arthur Bugler Primary School is a two form entry community schools serving the area of Stanford-le-Hope and Corringham. The school is situated at the top of Balmoral Avenue at the junction with St. James Avenue East and West. The schools can only be accessed by one road. The school is situated at the top of Balmoral Avenue which is at the top of the hill.

At present the school has only one entrance/exit, which services 14 classes of children. Currently there are 411 children, with the children aged from 4-11yrs old. We currently have 59 SEN children ; 51 SA or SA+ and 9 with Statements, some of which have Blue Disabled Badges. The official opening times vary by 5/10 minutes and but the longest times are 8.40am - 3.10pm. However, pre-school clubs start from 7.45am and after school activities finish at around 4.20pm. There are no walking or cycling paths nearby. There is a Bus route that runs along Southend Road adjacent to Balmoral Ave.

The school also shares the site with Graham James Primary Academy and Abbots Hall Primary Academy; these schools can be accessed from Arthur Bugler by cutting across the shared field. Consequently a lot of traffic and pedestrian movement takes place in a concentrated area, twice daily. None of the above schools were designed to cope with the vehicle levels that we see today. It was envisaged that the vast majority of families would walk to their neighbourhood school, although we now have over half of our children that come to use from outside of our catchment area. When the schools were built this was not the picture of the future and therefore no drop off points or lay-bys were put in place. In more recent times the Education Service has tried to discourage cars by putting in traffic calming measures in the neighbourhood. Our own school has decided to close the gates in the afternoons, except for blue disabled badge holders) to improve road safety and discourage the use of cars.

We have a pathway for pedestrians and bikes/scooters to share which is separate and secure from the main entrance used by cars. There is a school crossing patrol at the bottom of Balmoral Avenue, to help parents/carers and children to cross Southend Road safely. We have bike sheds and a Scooter/Bike park in the school. We have 2 small sheltered areas in the Key Stage 1 playgrounds, one in the Early Years area and one for Years 1 and 2, where families can wait before and after school in order to protect them from the weather. This is also a new sheltered area for Key Stage 2 for families to wait. Our Year 6 children take part in Cycling Proficiency, Year 1 children take part in Kerb Craft and we have Road Safety walks for Reception and Year 6 children all run by Thurrock Council. We also take part in the 'Walk to school week' and Walk to school Wednesday' initiatives which encourage families to walk more. We have an Eco-Warden club and have been part of the Healthy Schools initiative.

We have had the double yellow lines re-painted outside of the school to try and cut down on the amount of dangerous parking. The mobile parking team have also been visible to deter dangerous and illegal parking. We always reinforce travel safety through our regular newsletters. The development of the new DP world port will impact on the area both directly and indirectly.

Buses* There are bus stops at the bottom of the school road.
The 200 buses run to both ways to BASILDON Bus Station and GRAYS Bus Station Via Homesteads, Stanford Le Hope, Orsett, Chadwell St Mary
The bus timetables run frequently and link with the school opening and closing times.

Rail* There is a national rail station 1.2 miles from the school, which would take approximately 23 mins to walk to or a bus can be taken from the bottom of the school road to the station.
The trains run to Southend and London and stop at many local towns.

The school is situated near Southend Road, which runs through the town of Stanford-Le-Hope and which is easily accessible from a main A road the 'A13', this is located 1.4 miles from the school and has links with many local towns and the surrounding area and is very accessible to the school.

There is also a school crossing patrol at the bottom of Balmoral Avenue to help parent/carers and children to cross Southend Road safely.

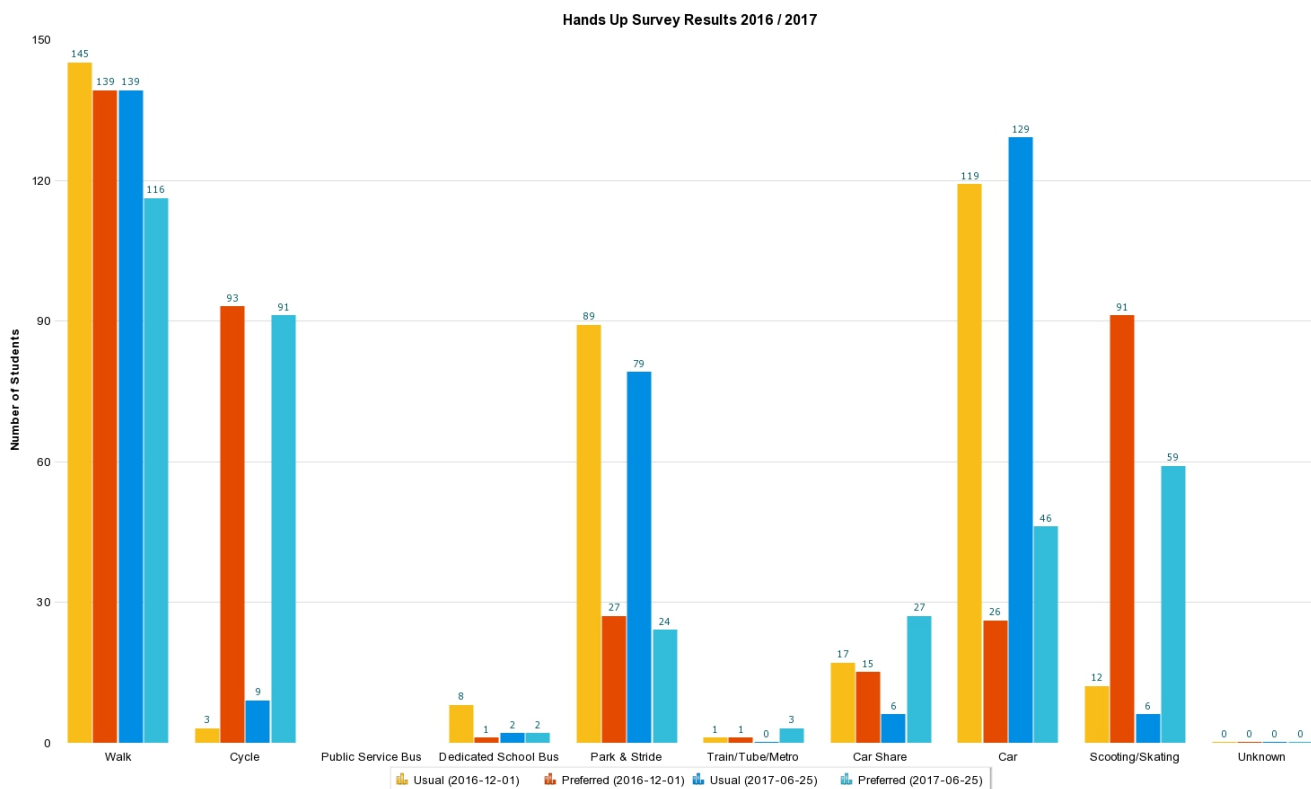

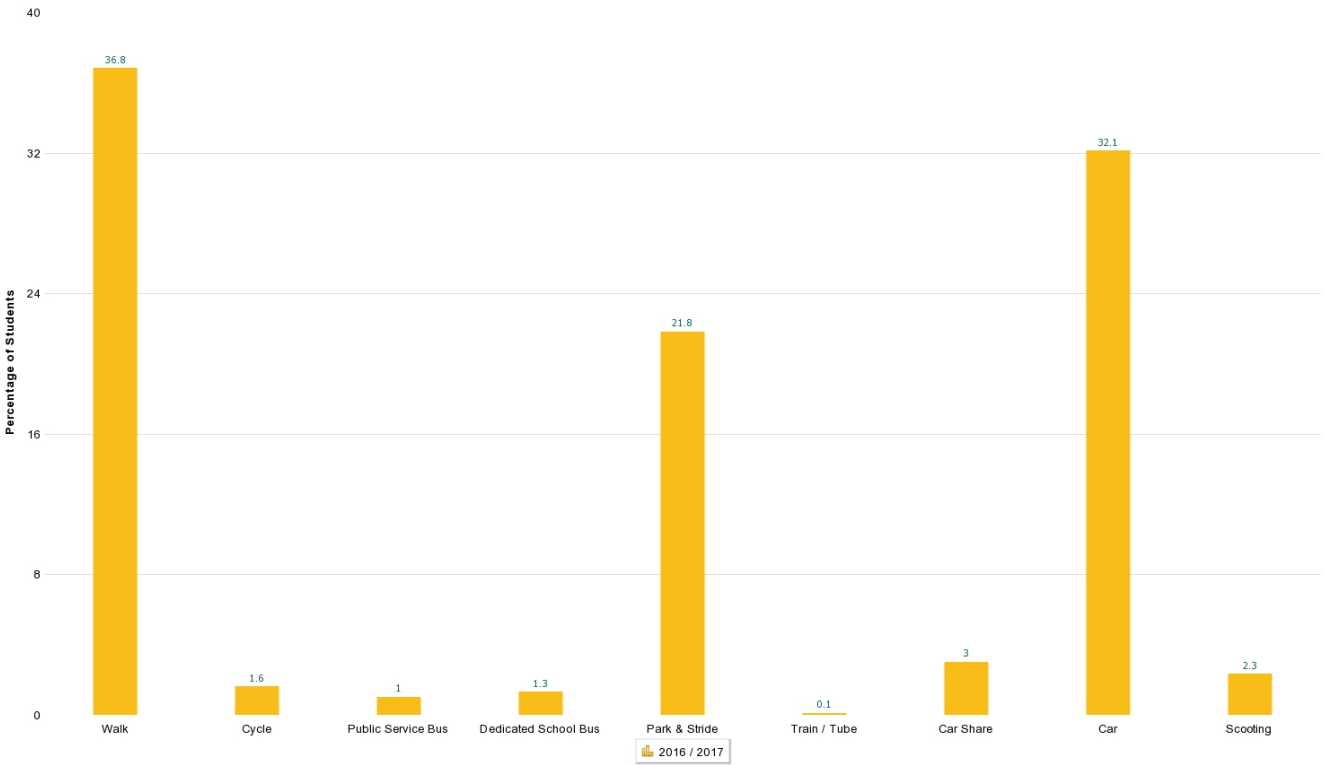

Modal Shift

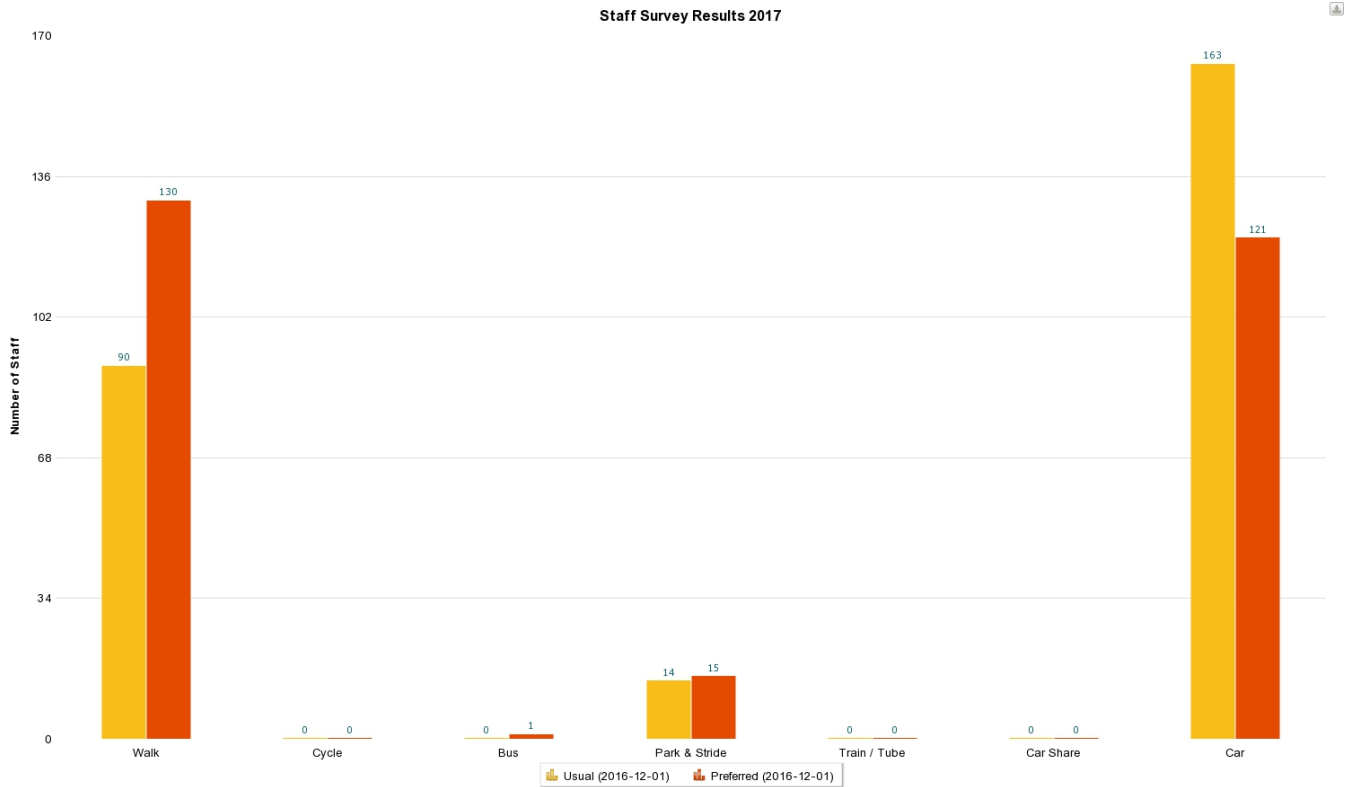
